Tony delighted in the command:

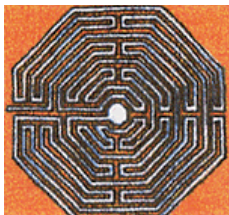
"Be a light unto yourself."

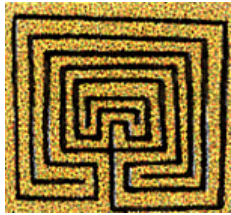

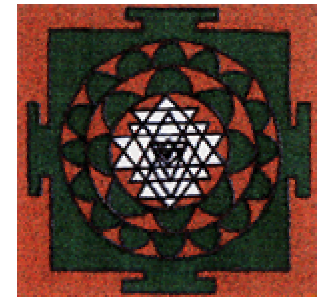
